Alief ISD Students

Did you know.....

- Alief ISD has not held a bond referendum since 2003.
- Alief ISD Board of Trustees has lowered the debt service tax rate by 6 cents over the last 5 years.
- Alief ISD's current total tax rate is \$1.28.
 - This tax rate is the 2nd lowest tax rate in the Houston area.
- Alief ISD has received a rating of “Superior Achievement” for the last 12 years in the Texas Education Agency’s Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas.



Tax Impact

- A taxpayer living in a home valued at \$100,000 that qualifies for a homestead exemption, may see an estimated increase of no more than **\$72.25/year** or **\$6.02/month** after all the bonds have been issued.
- Senior citizens (65 or older) whose property taxes are frozen would not be impacted.
- Even with the bond package, Alief ISD's tax rate will continue to be lower than most area school districts.
